Across Windle, we implement 9 programmes (although not all of them are implemented in every country), under which fall various specific projects. These programmes are: Early Childhood Development; Primary education; Secondary education; Vocational training; Tertiary education scholarships; Teacher education; Girls' education; English language training; and Education technology.

These programmes answer our four key strategic objectives:

- Increasing access to education
- Improving the quality of education
- Creating livelihoods
- Promoting peace




The Windle Ambassador programme aims to give you the chance to get involved in something they care about, to do something you will enjoy and that will fulfil you.
